**APPLICATION**

COMES NOW Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, hereinafter referred to as  
“Applicant,” “OG&E,” or “Company,” and hereby shows as follows:

**I. Parties.**

OG&E is an investor-owned electric public utility that owns and operates plant, property, and other assets used for the generation, production, transmission, distribution and sale of electric power and energy at wholesale and at retail in the states of Oklahoma and Arkansas. OG&E is incorporated in the State of Oklahoma, is subject to the regulatory authority of this Commission with respect to its retail rates and charges for sales of electricity made within the State of Oklahoma, and has its principal place of business at 321 N. Harvey, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73102. Applicant is represented for the purpose of these proceedings by the following named individuals whose addresses are reflected below:

## **II. Facts.**

A. On April 21, 2014, the Governor of the State of Oklahoma signed Senate Bill 1456 into law as Title 17, Oklahoma Statutes, Section 156 (the “Act”). This legislation amended portions of the existing Section 156 to address proper cost recovery from customers utilizing certain distributed generation (“DG”) devices that are connected to an electric utility’s distribution and transmission infrastructure.

B. The Act required retail suppliers, such as the Company, to “implement tariffs in compliance with this act no later than December 31, 2015.”

C. To comply with the Act, OG&E is proposing four new tariffs including: a commercial TOU tariff (COM-TOU-kW) and a residential TOU tariff (R-TOU-kW), a new net metering rider (NEBO-kW), and an additional QF rider (QF Select). The residential and commercial tariffs include demand billing charges, appropriately priced connection charges (customer charges), and appropriately priced time-differentiated energy charges. These tariffs were all developed using Unit Cost components from the last approved rate case. These tariffs are attached as Exhibits in the Direct Testimony of Roger Walkingstick filed in this matter.

D. Concurrent with the approval of these tariffs, OG&E intends to close the existing NEBO tariff to new DG facilities.

## **III. Legal Authority.**




